Day 1:

Day 3:

After Lunch enjoy your tour visiting:

- The High Dam which was completed in 1964. From here you can gaze across Lake Nasser.
- The Philae temple Sail by felucca (Egyptian sailboat) to the island of Agilkia. Visit the temple that was removed from their original island of Philae which lies submerged most of the year by the waters of Lake Nasser. The main Temple of Isis and its monuments were built between the 26th-dynasty and the Roman period.

Day 4:

After breakfast, continue sailing to KomOmbo, to see the unique Temple of Sobek, dedicated to Sobek the crocodile god, and Horus the falcon-headed god. After the visit you will be back to the Cruise Ship and sail to Edfu. Visit to the Temple Of Horus. Enjoy the beautiful Nile while sailing to Esna, Luxor and overnight there.

Once you reach Esna you can watch as it sails through the Esna Locks.

- The Old part of Cairo, as Egypt was one of the first countries to embrace Christianity. We visit The Church of St. Barbara & Abu-Serga one of the places where the Holy Family rested after fleeing Israel from King Herod. At the turn of the century this little church, which dates from the 10th-century, was the most important pilgrimage spot in Old Cairo for visiting Christian tourists. There are 24 marble columns lining the central court, and a series of 12th-century icons depicting the 12 apostles.
- Followed by a Visit to The Mosque of Amr Ibn El-Aas the first and oldest mosque ever built on the land of Egypt.
